  - i. KCI application
- S. Massel provided background information on the application stating KCI submitted two grant applications, the first grant was to hire a student to archive material and the second grant was to renovate the foyer to install display cases. She highlighted a number of elements missing from the grant applications. S. Massel noted that she tried to work with the applicant to get the missing pieces but was unsuccessful.
